PETRON FUELS WORKSHOP ON WHEEL ALONG PLUS HIGHWAY

Kuala Lumpur – As part of its Road Safety program to ensure safer and more convenient travels, Petron Malaysia recently signed a six-month deal to exclusively supply fuel to Workshop on Wheels (WOW), the emergency roadside assistance provider of highway operator PLUS Malaysia Berhad.

Nine Petron service stations along the 850-kilometer North-South Expressway, Butterworth-Kulim Expressway and Linkedua will be fueling all WOW vehicles comprising 16 vans, 6 motorcycles and 6 two trucks with its high quality Petron Blaze fuels until the end of the year.

Under this partnership, customers with Petron Miles card needing WOW's services will enjoy 6% GST-free services. Customers will also enjoy Petron's premium engine oil Blaze Racing at a special price, offered on WOW vehicles during roadside emergency assistance.

To commemorate the partnership, 20,000 limited edition of 'PLUS Miles Touch 'n Go-Petron Card' was launched, offering a 5% toll rebate on all PLUS highways. It is available for sale at participating Petron stations in Klang Valley, Penang and Johor at RM10.60 (inclusive of 6% GST).

WOW service is a service collaboration between PLUS and Automobile Association of Malaysia offered to highway users during breakdowns and protects motorists from unauthorised tow truckers. WOW offers free towing service and minor servicing for breakdowns among others, for the entire North-South Expressway, around the clock.

"This partnership is also an extension of our support to make our roads safer, while offering convenience to motorists to get on safely to their destinations", continues Pn Faridah Ali.

Petron has always been a strong advocate of road safety. It runs a countrywide Road Safety Program for motorists particularly during festive seasons, and offers Safety Riding Classes to student motorists at colleges and universities. It reached close to 300 students last year and this year, it plans to continue the same program in more higher learning institutions.

Petron is also the first oil industry participant in the government's "United Against Crime" project with its "Go-To-Safety-Points" or GTSP. Under the program, the Company has transformed its service stations into "safe havens" for the public in case they need police assistance.
