KUALA LUMPUR — The finale of the F4 SEA (F4 SEA) Championship season 2017-18 will be presented here in Sepang from 13 to 15 April 2018, and will be fueled by Petron Malaysia - the official fuel and engine oil partner of the F4 SEA Championship.

Nazim, who also competes in Europe, along with other Malaysian drivers, will be up against the likes of Daniel Cao (China), Kane Shepherd (Thailand), Ugo De Wilde (Belgium) and other foreign competitors.

“We were very excited watching the earlier rounds which were all competitive and featured high quality racing. The action will continue in the next round and it is our hope that racing fans will come out and support these young talents”, Faridah added.

The Formula 4 SEA event supports the Malaysian Championship Series (MCS) when it stages the finale of the Championship from 13 to 15 April 2018.

Entrance to the race is free and the public are encouraged to give support to Malaysian drivers.
