

## PETRON POWERS SUPERBIKERS IN 1 MALAYSIA BIKE WEEK 2012

**KUALA LUMPUR, 8 NOVEMBER** – Petron Malaysia, which manages and operates Petron, Esso and Mobil service stations, is sponsoring the fuels for the 1 Malaysia Bike Week, from November 6 until November 11, 2012.

They had earlier distributed the safety helmets at The Zon Hotel in Johor Bahru, Laman Belia, Sg Rambai in Melaka and Universiti Kolej Teknologi Bistari, Setiu in Terengganu.
