In each category, the first prize winner will receive RM3,000, second place winner will receive RM2,000 and the third place winner will receive RM1,000. Consolation prizes of RM500 will also be awarded to three winners in each category.

All Vision Petron 2018 participants will receive an e-certificate upon submission of artwork. An art exhibit will be held during and after the award ceremony to honor the winning artists.

Previous winning artworks were featured in premium items that are given out to Petron customers and partners such as diaries, wall and desk calendars, t-shirts, umbrellas and water tumblers.
