Students have a chance to win cash prizes amounting to RM15,000.00 and recognition plaques. Prizes for both categories are: First prizes, RM3,000 each;

Second prizes, RM2,000 each; Third prizes, RM1,000 each; and Consolation prizes, RM500 for three winners per category. Winners will be notified personally or through a phone call from Petron Malaysia.
